



Notice of Trust Vote October 27, 2020



On **October 27, 2020**, our communities will be holding a vote on the proposals to access income from the PTFN Trust. Vote Polling stations will be in the Community Halls in both Peerless Lake and Trout Lake and at the Red Earth Community Hall for off-reserve members. Voting will be by secret ballot and will take place from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m.

In order to vote you must be a PTFN member that is at least 18 years of age. Please bring valid photo identification. The proposals that you will be voting on are included in the Trust Newsletter. The vote is being held in accordance with the Trust Agreement that was included in the claim settlement that our community voted YES to in March of 2010.

<p>Proposal A – Community Health and Safety Supporting emergency preparedness, fire services and enhanced policing. This program would replace the Emergency Response Program that was previously approved.</p>	<p>\$311,500</p>
<p>Proposal B – Funeral Support Program – budget increase. Providing financial support to help pay for funerals for local families. The previously approved yearly budget is \$20,000.</p>	<p>\$40,000</p>
