



Peerless Trout First Nation Trust Program Vote 2020

Notice of Results – October 30, 2020

In keeping with the requirements of the Peerless Trout First Nation Trust, membership was required to vote on proposed community initiatives to be funded by the net income of the Trust. This year Council carefully reviewed proposals that were put forward to fill gaps in funding that were identified in existing community programs that were already approved for funding through a previous Trust Program vote.

A proposal is considered approved if a majority of Eligible Voters who cast a ballot vote “YES” for the proposal. A total of 405 Ballots were cast by Peerless Trout First Nation Eligible Voters, meaning a minimum of 203 “YES” votes were required for a proposal to be approved. The Results of the Trust Proposal vote held on October 27, 2020 are as follows:

Proposal A - Emergency Preparedness and Community Safety:

Both proposals were approved by 83% of the Eligible voters that cast a ballot in the Trust vote. Chief and Council and the Trustees will now be able to include these amended programs for consideration in the annual Trust Programs budget.
