**TO: MEMBERS OF PEERLESS TROUT FIRST NATION**

**TAKE NOTICE** that a Community Approval Vote shall be held in accordance with the Peerless Trout First Nation Community Approval Vote Process in order to determine if Eligible Voters approve the **Trust Proposals**. The **Trust Proposals** shall be approved if a majority of the participating Eligible Voters vote to approve them.

The following question will be asked of the Eligible Voters of Peerless Trout First Nation by ballot:

**“Do you approve of this budget proposed by the Trustees and that these programs and services be paid for out of the Net Income of the Trust?”**

The Official Voting Day for the Community Approval Vote will take place on **Wednesday the 12 day of June, 2024 from 9 a.m. until 8 p.m.** at:

- The Peerless Lake Community Hall in Peerless Lake, Alberta;
- Trout Lake Community Hall, Alberta; and
- Electronic-voting.




